Febelco, Belgium's largest pharmaceutical wholesaler, faced significant challenges with its manual invoice processing system. Seeking automation to reduce workload and increase accuracy, Febelco partnered with Dynatos to implement the invoice capture solution and the Routty system.

### **Diagnosing the issue**

Febelco's manual invoice processing involved line-by-line checks, coding, and data entry into their accounting software. This labor-intensive process required seven full-time employees and was prone to human error. The growing volume of invoices highlighted the inefficiencies and the need for automation to maintain scalability without proportionally increasing the workforce. Febelco is currently processing approximately 240.000 invoices on an annual basis, utilizing several streamlined workflows to ensure efficient and accurate management. This extensive volume necessitates robust systems and procedures to handle the various stages of invoice processing, from receipt to finalization. These workflows are meticulously designed to optimize processing times, reduce errors, and maintain compliance with financial regulations. Implementing these diverse flows underscores Febelco's commitment to operational excellence and ability to handle substantial financial transactions seamlessly.

### Initiating the treatment

Febelco selected Dynatos for their expertise in digital financial transformations. The implementation of the Routty system, along with AP Essentials for invoice capture, had its first results in September 2020. The system stabilized over time as custom logic and adaptations to Febelco's specific requirements were implemented. Throughout the transition, Dynatos provided continuous support, ensuring the system was tailored to Febelco's workflows and specifications.

### Implementation and onboarding
